## RELIGION

Strengthening our relationship with God and Jesus through prayer, including a student-led Rosary Service, and serving at Matthew 25 Ministries.

## MATH

Enhancing understanding of place value, larger numbers, basic math facts, rounding, multiplication, division, fractions, and problem-solving.

## READING & LANGUAGE ARTS

## SCIENCE & HEALTH

Focusing on Ohio's geography, history, and significance while memorizing all 50 states and capitals and studying U.S. regions.
