



# KINDERGARTEN CURRICULUM

## RELIGION

Obtain basic knowledge of the Catholic faith, traditions, and sacraments and attend liturgy weekly.

## READING

Master foundational skills, learning grade-level phonics and word analysis skills. Apply reading comprehension strategies and demonstrate command of standard English grammar conventions and usage when writing or speaking.

## MATH

Count and write numerals to 100 and beyond; compare numbers; represent and solve addition and subtraction using objects, drawings, etc. Fluently add and subtract within 5, and compose and decompose numbers into tens and ones.

## SOCIAL STUDIES

Learn about goods and services, wants and needs, communities, maps and symbols, timelines, cultures, and traditions worldwide and at home.

## SCIENCE

Distinguish characteristics of living and non-living things, and learn about Earth and space. Discover the properties of objects and how to think like a scientist.

## SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL

Learn how to be a friend and responsible member of their community. Gain independence by learning to solve problems.

## TECHNOLOGY

Use Chromebooks to navigate various websites to increase student achievement across the curriculum.
