

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR THE 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR!

For the past two years, the USDA has offered waivers to Child Nutrition (CN) Programs across the United States, allowing these programs to offer all students breakfast and lunch, at no charge. **These waivers will expire on June 30, 2022.** This means that starting next school year, 2022-2023, the CN programs across the nation will return to pre-pandemic operations. Families <u>will</u> once again be asked to complete and submit a current school year Free/Reduced Meal Application if they would like to see if their students qualify based on income or category eligibility. In the past years, the first 30 days of the school year carried over the meal status from the previous school year. Since there were very few meal applications submitted over the past couple of years, it is <u>very important</u> for families to apply as soon as possible for the 2022-23 school year and eliminate the possibility of charges and alternate meals.

- *** Free/Reduced meal applications will be available starting on **August 1, 2022**.
- *** NEW this year, parents will apply using QuikApps as part of the PaySchools parent portal.

The first time you log in, you will need to indicate which student(s) to attach to your account using the Add/View student tab. Students are already loaded in the PaySchools Central system. PaySchools Central utilizes the same student ID number used for your lunch purchases. If you are unsure of your student's ID number, please call 513-576-2290.

****Reminder: When creating your account you will need to choose the District "Milford EVSD"

For Finneytown students, add a 3 at the beginning of your student ID#

For John Paul II students, add an 8 at the beginning of your student ID #

For St. Columban students, add a 2 at the beginning of your student ID#

For Williamsburg students, add a 1 at the beginning of your student ID#

For Wyoming students, add a 4 at the beginning of your student ID#

For Norwood students, add a 6 at the beginning of your student ID#

****Parents will need to set up their own account restrictions and balance transfers in the parent portal. You will need to restart the auto replenish and low balance notifications for the new school year.

Breakfast (For participating schools): \$1.75, .30 for reduced

Lunch: **Elem. K-6** \$2.75 **Jr. High and MS** \$3.00 for regular meal, super \$3.50 **HS** \$3.00 regular, \$3.50 super, \$4.00 deluxe, Parochial Schools \$2.75 (all reduced lunches .40)

Milk: .60
